THE PROCESS

We work closely with domestic violence support services to fully understand the situation. We meet with the victimsurvivor to discuss strategies to keep them safe.

All work is coordinated hand in hand with the victim-survivor. They need to be a part of the plan, and have control and input on the strategy, from installing security upgrades through to safety planning and response.





THE PROCESS

Ultimately, our goal is to assist the victim-survivor to feel in control, and understand that we are there for them throughout this process.

Many victim-survivors have felt powerless or controlled by someone else for some time, this is a very important element in their journey to take back control of their life.





THE PROCESS

Once we have all the relevant information, the process can commence.

We carry out vulnerability assessments, and conduct safety planning with the family in the home, school and/or work environments. We also carry out sweeps for hidden cameras, listening devices and tracking devices.

All recommendations are made and provided to the supporting DV service for consultation and approval.



Our role is to tailor solutions that focus on the safety of victim-survivors, and if required, remove them from complex or dangerous situations.





We do this with an unprecedented level of care. Our number one focus is our client, and managing their overall safety and security effectively.
